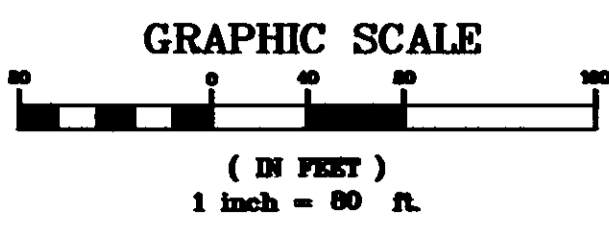


MAP OF SURVEY THEODORE HACH ESTATE

The basis of bearings for this survey is North 86°-01'-40" East as the centerline of Fay Road, as evidenced by monuments found, and is the same bearing as found in the Vacation of BreezeWood Drive (60'), recorded in Volume 52, Page 28 of the Lake County Records. Distances are given in feet and decimal parts thereof. All iron pins shown as set are 30" long 5/8" rebar with an identification cap stamped "McSTEEN 7104".

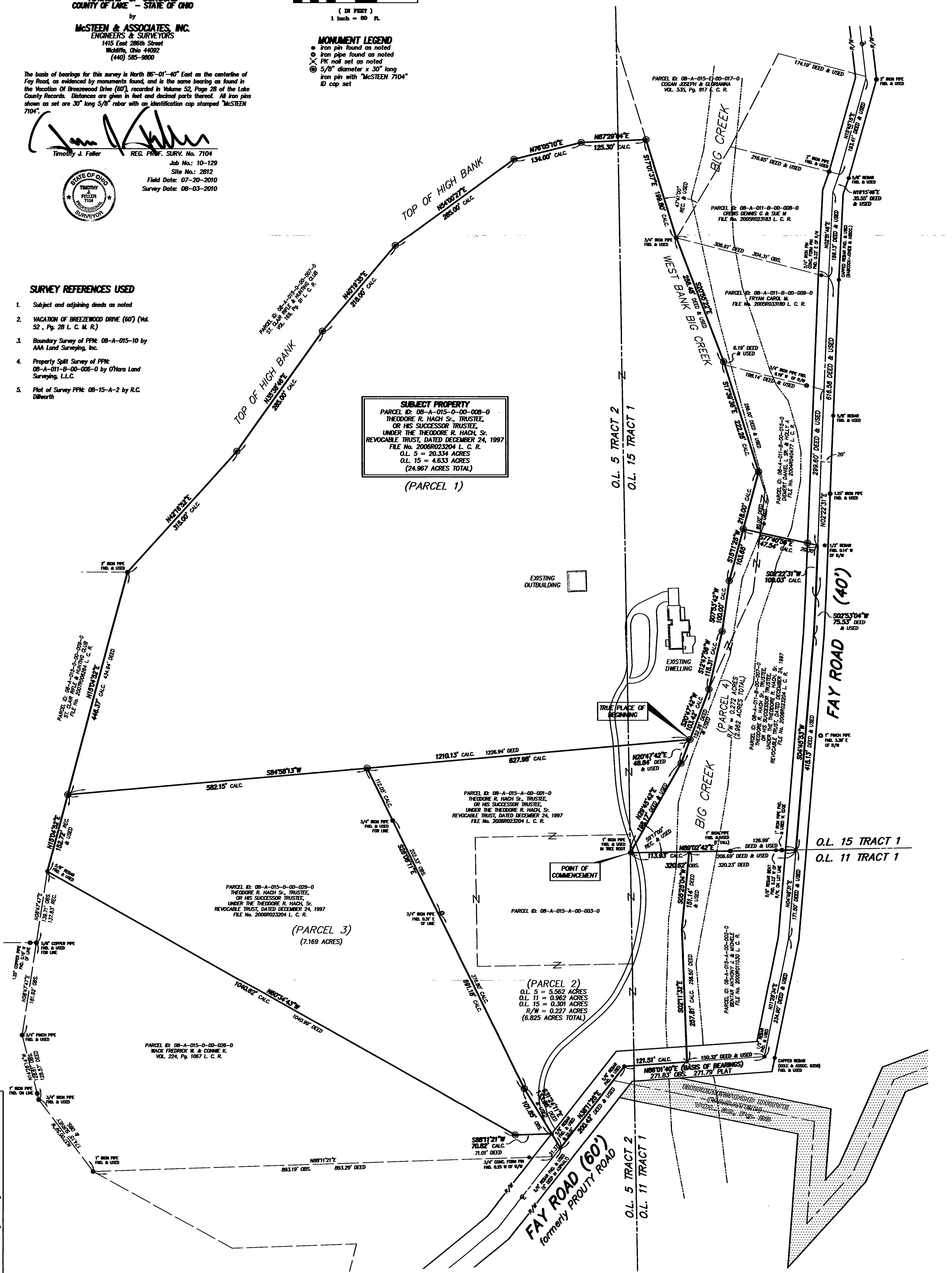
